



PILLARS LOWER SCHOOL PROGRAM

- Available for students in K-6th grade
- 4 hours per week of intervention/consultation in the classroom, before or after school tutoring and/or direct instruction individually or in small groups
- Personalized academic goals, home program support (if desired), and accommodations plan developed for each student
- Accommodations information and training given to regular education teacher to enhance classroom learning (documentation from testing needed to support accommodations-screening/evaluation required)
- Modification in curriculum available to students with formal documentation of learning challenge (documented learning difference required)
- Homework and classwork support (re-teaching and in class support) as well as test taking support and training
- Accommodations and training given to regular education teacher to enhance classroom learning
- Assistance in organization and study skills
- The use of assistive technology and physical support materials to aide in attending and learning as needed
- Specific computer software programs (i.e. Reading Naturally; Earobics) and other support materials to strengthen learning challenges; individually designed for each student
- Use of assistive technology (computers, ipads, etc.) as needed
- Development of behavioral support plan (if needed)
- Weekly monitoring and goal coaching to encourage responsibility and self-awareness
- Social skills support through peer mentoring and/or by PILLARS staff
- Frequent communication between classroom teachers, home and PILLARS facilitating accountability and follow through
- Maintain the same curriculum as The Rock Academy with supplemental learning material to strengthen areas of focus
- After school support one or two days to help with homework as well as strengthen areas of learning processes
