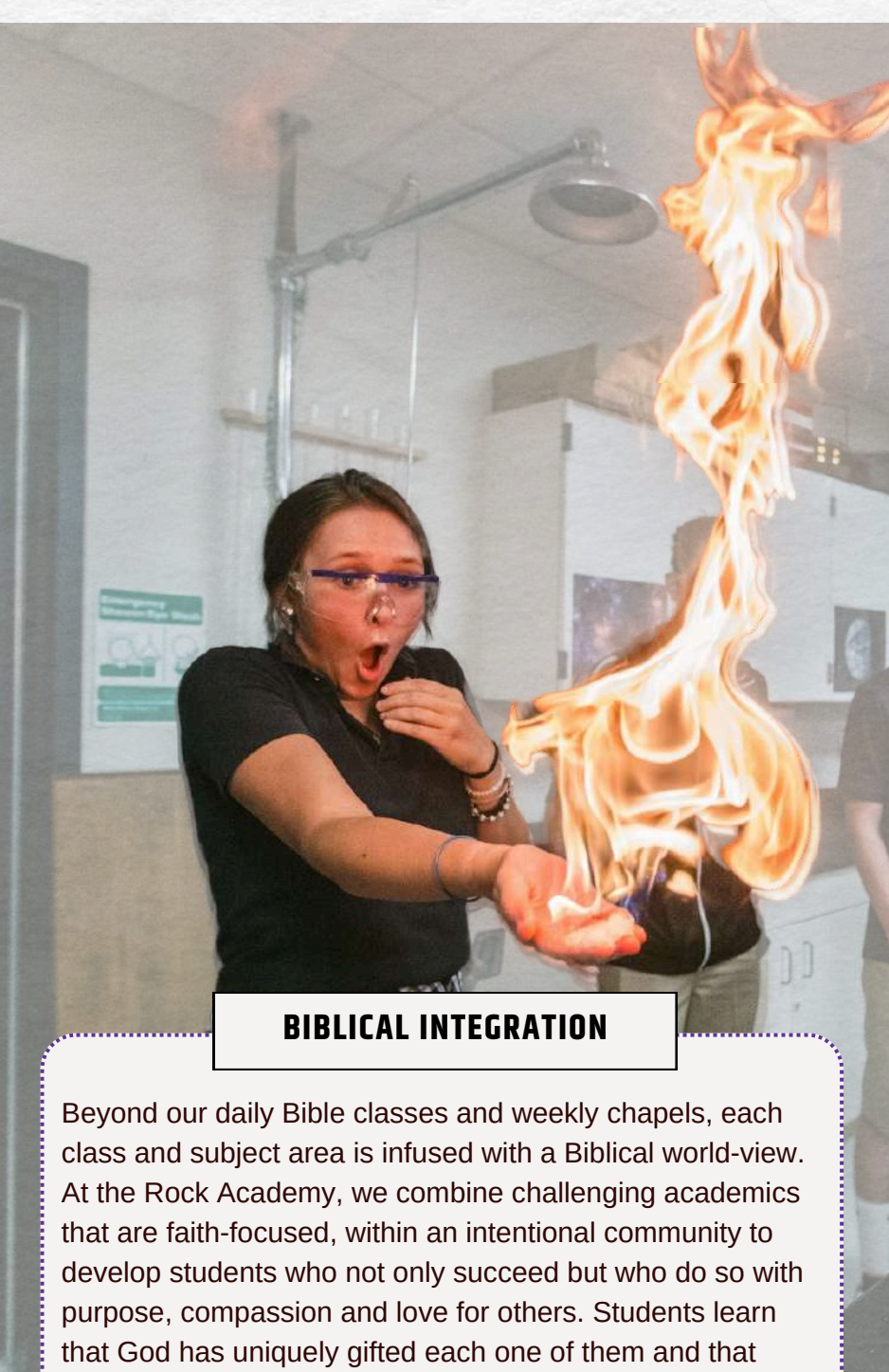

The Rock Academy is an independent, faith-based, PK-12th grade school. Founded in 2002 the Academy launched with thirty-eight students, grades K-6. In 2003 the Rock Academy expanded to serve 7th and 8th grade students. In 2007 the Rock Academy re-located to its current location in Point Loma and launched the high school. The Rock now serves over 500 students PK-12th grade. The Rock Academy is the only faith-based school serving the greater downtown area of San Diego.

Beyond our daily Bible classes and weekly chapels, each class and subject area is infused with a Biblical world-view. At the Rock Academy, we combine challenging academics that are faith-focused, within an intentional community to develop students who not only succeed but who do so with purpose, compassion and love for others. SCHOOL CALENDAR

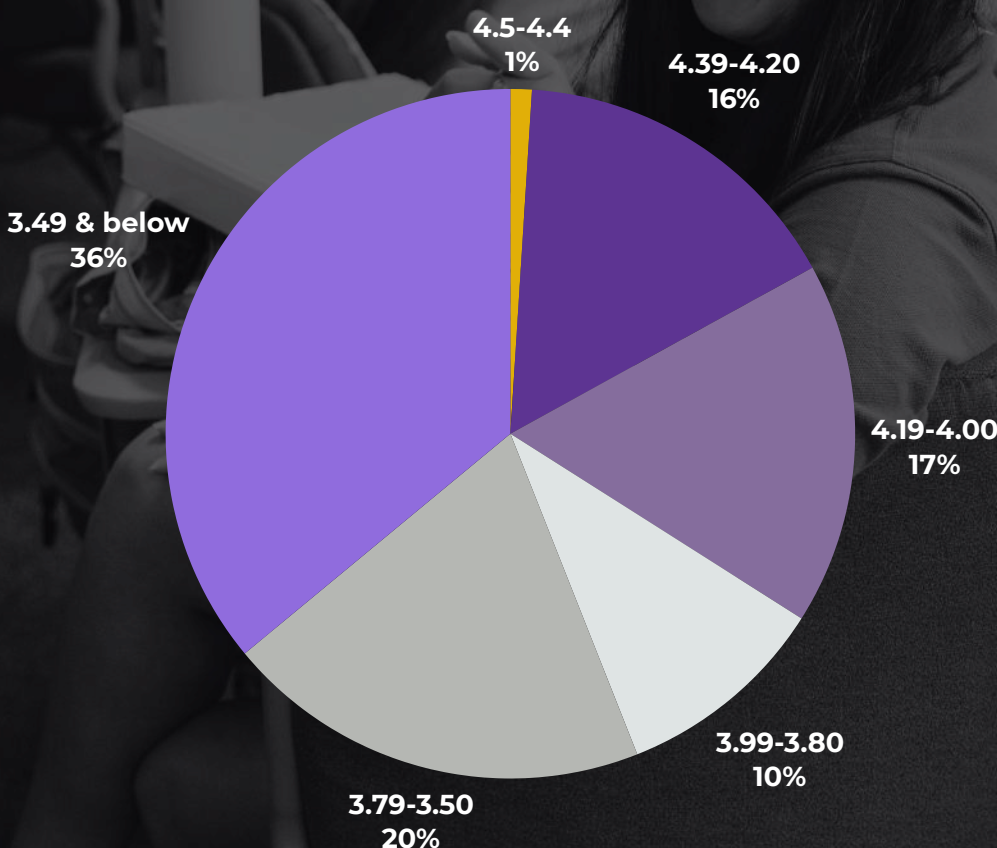
Two semesters of approximately equal length. Each semester has two quarters of reported grades.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE

The GPA is computed each semester, annually and cumulatively. All graded courses are reflected in the cumulative GPA. AP and Honors courses are weighted equally with an extra point in the GPA. **The Rock Academy does not rank and the GPA is based on a 4.0 scale.** GPA listed on the transcript is a weighted GPA.

GPA DISTRIBUTION

Given the graduating class size, the Rock uses a three-year sample size to more accurately reflect student performance. This distribution is based on graduating classes 2024, 2023 and 2022.



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Rock Academy meets or exceeds all UC admissions requirements.

The Rock Academy uses a running three-year average for reporting SAT, ACT and AP scores. Given the smaller size of each graduating class, we believe this is a more accurate reflection of the overall strength of our student body. Every 12th grade student takes either the SAT or ACT regardless of their post-secondary plans. Every student who enrolls in an AP course takes the AP exam regardless of their post-secondary plans. Due to the Rock Academy graduation requirement of 8 semesters of Bible courses, a students' ability to take multiple AP courses in a school year is limited.

AP AND HONORS COURSE OFFERINGS

BASED ON THE LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY AND EFFORT REQUIRED TO SUCCEED IN AP LEVEL COURSES, ROCK STUDENTS ARE ADVISED TO TAKE NO MORE THAN TWO AP COURSES A YEAR.

HOWEVER, SOME STUDENTS CHOOSE TO CHALLENGE THEMSELVES WITH MORE THAN TWO AP COURSES. AP COURSES ARE ONLY OFFERED TO STUDENTS IN GRADES 10-12.

AP ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE, AND AP CALCULUS AND AP STATISTICS ARE OFFERED ON ALTERNATING YEARS.

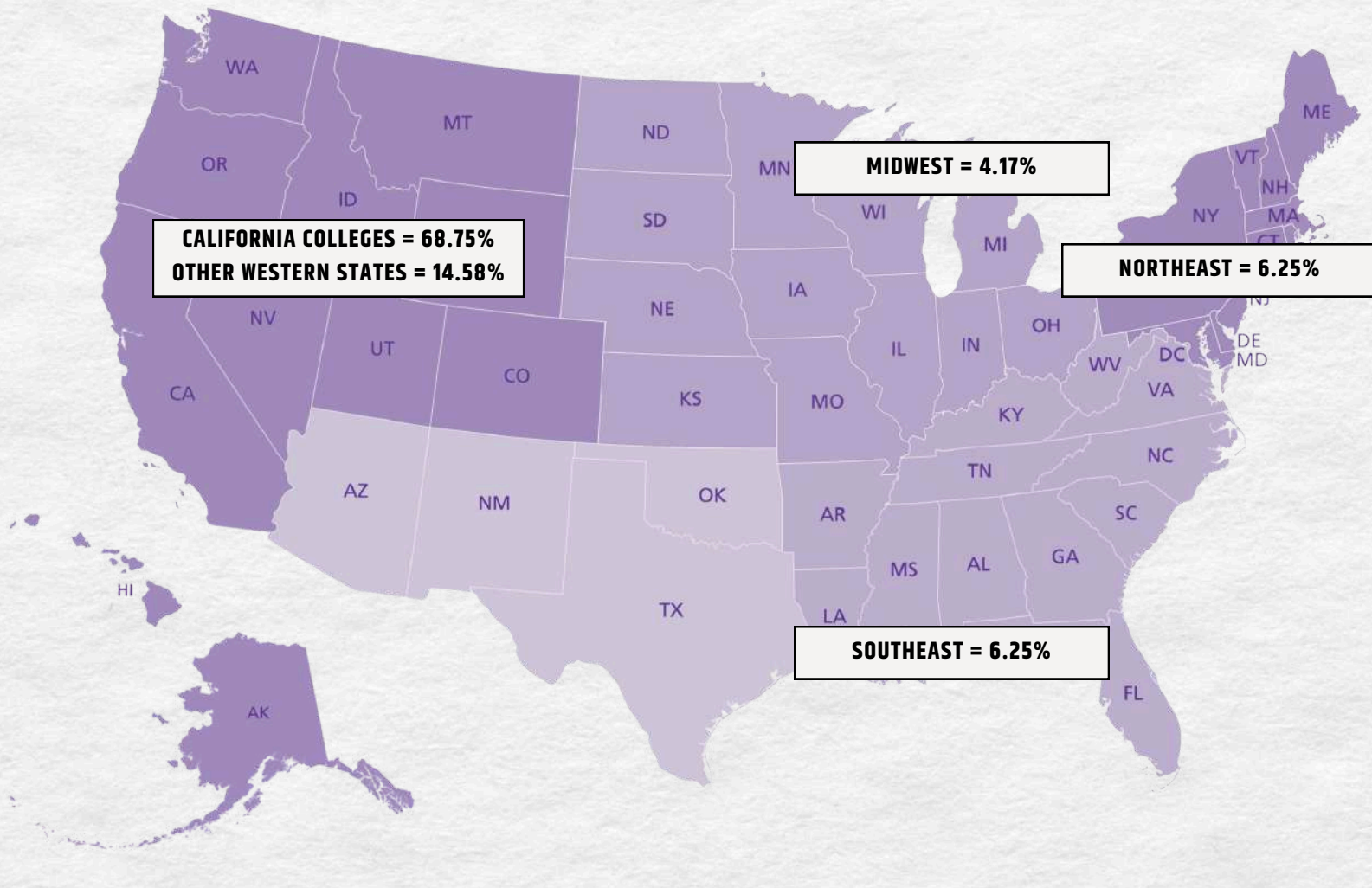
