Average class size: 17

Students attend 4 classes per day 97% of graduates attend college

The Rock Academy does not compute class rank. The school operates on a semester basis with grades issued at nine week intervals. Grade point average is based on courses taken in grades 9-12. For AP and Honors classes, an extra grade point is added for each semester; grades below a C- are not weighted. Transfer courses at the Honors and AP level are only accepted for a weighted grade if the Academy offers an equivalent course.

In September, 2002, the Rock Academy opened its doors to 38 K - 6th grade students with a standalone Kindergarten class, and combination classes for 1st/2nd, 3rd/4th, and 5th/6th along with 1 administrator, 1 support staff, and 4 teachers. The preschool had 1 director, 1 assistant director and 3.5 teachers. By the end of the academic year, 2003, the Academy had grown to 50 students and 1 additional support staff, while the preschool gained another 44. In September, 2003, the Rock Academy opened the 7th and 8th grades as the school continued to expand in students and staff. The Rock Academy moved to its new home in Point Loma in August 2007 and launched its high school. During the 2023-2024 school year, the Rock Academy continued to expand with enrollment of 566 students from Preschool-12th grade.
