



Core A-G Courses

These foundational courses meet the academic rigor required for UC college preparatory studies.

A - History: 2 years.

B - English: 4 years.

C - Mathematics: 3 years (through Algebra II). *4 years*

recommended.

D - Laboratory Science: 2 years.

Additional A-G Requirements

E - Language Other Than English: 2 consecutive years of the same language.

F - Visual/Performing Arts: 1 year (within the same discipline).

G - College Preparatory Elective: 1 additional year from any A-F category.

All courses offered at The Rock Academy are officially approved to fulfill A-G requirements.

Early Action Admissions: Key Considerations

1 Non-Binding

Early Action applications are non-binding. Accepted students are not obligated to enroll and can consider other offers until the regular decision deadline.

2 Early Notification

Applicants receive admission decisions earlier, allowing for timely planning and decision-making.

3 Restricted Policies

Some institutions have "Restricted Early Action," limiting applicants to applying Early Action solely to that institution, while still allowing regular decision applications elsewhere.



Early Decision Characteristics



Binding Commitment

If admitted, applicants are
committed to enrolling.



Expedited Notification

Admissions decisions are received earlier.



Admission Advantage
May increase likelihood of
admission.



Regular Decision Admissions: Key Aspects



Flexible Commitment

Evaluate all admission offers before committing.



Enhanced Profile

Use fall grades to strengthen applications. Compare offers thoroughly before deciding.



Key Dates

Applications close Jan-Feb. Decisions released Apr-May.



Non-Binding Admissions Overview



Flexibility

Non-binding offers allow applicants to defer enrollment decisions, maintaining options until a final commitment is made.



Expedited Timelines

Applications, such as Rolling Admissions, often provide decisions within 4-6 weeks, offering quick feedback.



Strategic Review

This approach enables students to thoroughly compare financial aid, academic programs, and campus environments across institutions.




Navigating the UC Application: Essential Elements

Academic Self-Reporting

Applicants must accurately self-report academic coursework and grades. Organized transcripts are crucial for this process.

Extracurricular Activities

Detail extracurricular activities and significant awards. Provide comprehensive context and specific details to highlight involvement and achievements.

CSU Application Requirements



Academic Record

Applicants self-report all academic coursework and grades directly on the application.

Organized transcripts are recommended.



Online Submission

The CSU application is submitted exclusively online via the California State University system website.



No Recommendations Required

The CSU application does not require submission of recommendation letters.

Widespread Access


Apply to over 800 diverse institutions globally through one centralized platform.

Key Components

Includes academic transcripts, standardized test scores (often optional), activities list, essays, and recommendations.

Key Aspects of Private College Applications



Application Decision Plans

Private colleges offer various admission plans, including Early Decision, Early Action, and Regular Decision. Choosing the right plan is key for applicants.



Understanding Acceptance Rates

Acceptance rates at private institutions vary significantly.



Standardized Testing Policies

Many private colleges are test-optional, but submitting strong SAT/ACT scores is often encouraged if they enhance your application.



Financial Aid Opportunities

Private colleges frequently provide robust financial aid packages, including grants and scholarships, offering more flexibility than public institutions.



College Application Essentials

Application Platforms

Submit your primary application through designated platforms: University Portals, the Common Application, or the Coalition Application.

Letters of Recommendation

Request insightful letters from counselors, educators, or others who can speak to your capabilities and character. Supplemental Essays

Many institutions require supplemental essays. Use these to highlight personal experiences and qualifications.

Academic Resume

Submit a resume highlighting academic achievements, extracurriculars, and relevant experiences.

Application Timeline

Effective planning is key for college applications. Track important dates and deadlines to ensure timely submission.

August 1 Rolling admissions begin. UC and Common Application portals open. October 1 UC filing period starts. CSU application and FAFSA open. November 3 UC and CSU application filing periods close on November 30th. November 1 - November 15 Typical deadlines for Early Action (EA) and Early Decision (ED) applications.

Dates are approximate. Always consult each institution's official website for precise deadlines and requirements.

FAFSA Information

FAFSA Opening Date

The FAFSA opens annually on October 1st. While there's no federal closing date, submit by June 2nd to maximize eligibility for state and institutional aid.

Application Process

The FAFSA is primarily an online application. Complete all required fields accurately to avoid processing delays.
