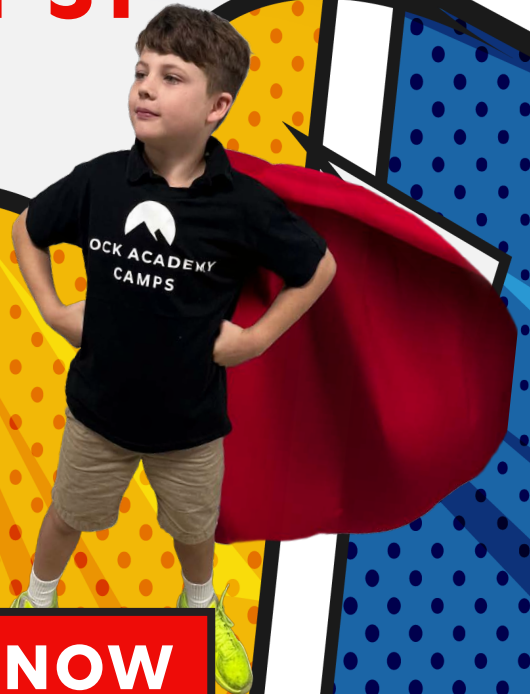

THIS CAMP MAY TRAVEL OFF CAMPUS FOR SOME ACTIVITIES

Lots of activities may take place within walking distance, but if traveling in a van, all campers are expected to understand and follow transportation rules. Drivers try to keep a consistent schedule of arrival and departure times. Times may vary per camp, per day. Each day, drivers perform a pre-trip inspection of their assigned van.

Booster seats are REQUIRED by law for children under the age of 8 years old, or under 4'9 tall.



ABOUT OUR CAMPS THAT INCLUDE SWIMMING

Campers must bring a towel, bathing suit, and sunscreen for some or all of the activities related to this camp. A proper change of clothes, hat, and backpack or beach bag is recommended. Campers may be required to take a swim test for this camp. If your child does not pass, they will not be able to participate in pool/ocean activities. Campers may wear sandals/flip-flops during water activities, but must have closed-toed shoes while on-campus.

LEADER IN TRAINING APPLICATION

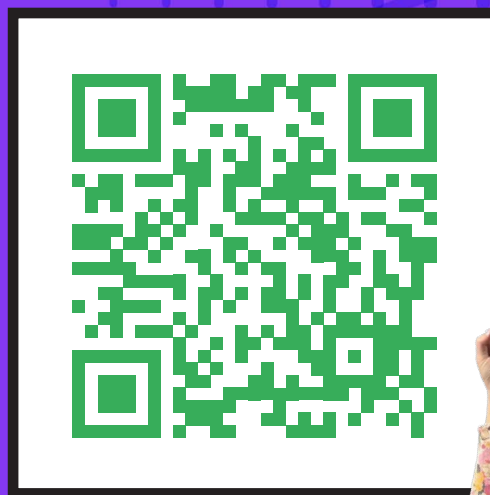

GENERAL INFORMATION & POLICIES

MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT

In order to attend Rock Academy Camps, your child's fifth (5) birthday must be before May 25, 2026.

TRANSFER & REFUND POLICY

CAMP TRANSFER POLICY

Parents may transfer from one camp to another within the same session if there is space available. If the transfer is completed at least two weeks prior to the session start date, there is no financial penalty. If the transfer is done after this period, a \$25 late transfer charge will be applied.

CAMP REFUND POLICY

All deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable. Children absent 3 or more days in a session due to illness or injury may receive a prorated credit or refund. Credit or refund requests must be submitted in writing for director approval within one week of the absence and must include a doctor's note. Credit and refunds will not be issued for missed days due to a vacation. All camp fees are non-refundable one week prior to the session start date. If we cancel a camp, you will receive a full refund or credit toward another RAC activity.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Parents may transfer from one camp to another within the same session if there is space available. If the transfer is completed at least two weeks prior to the session start date, there is no financial penalty. If the transfer is done after this period, a \$25 late transfer charge will be applied.

PAYMENT PROCEDURE

Balances remaining after deposit will be due on MONDAY, one week prior to the start of each camp. If it is not paid, an automatic payment will be made on the card that was used to pay the deposit. There is a \$10 late fee for payments received after the due date or for sign-ups on the first day of the camp session.

GENERAL INFORMATION & POLICIES (CONT.)

RELEASE WAIVERS

You will receive your camp confirmation along with any required release waivers via e-mail within two weeks of registration. It is your responsibility to contact RAC if you do not receive the confirmation or the proper release waivers. Required release waivers are noted on inside camp descriptions.

SUNSCREEN

Please be sure to send your child to camp with SPF-30 or higher with child's name clearly marked. Sunscreen will be applied at least 3 times during the day. Your child's sunscreen will be kept with their belongings.

DROP OFF/ PICK UP

WHERE TO DROP OFF/ PICK UP

Drop Off and Pick Up will take place at the Cafeteria entrance, which is accessible through the building Lobby. We will sign in and sign out electronically.

SIGN IN & OUT POLICY

Parents MUST sign their child IN and OUT each day. Only parents or persons authorized in writing will be allowed to pick up a child. Photo ID is ALWAYS required. We also ask that, for the safety of the children at the camp, you only come to the cafeteria for sign-in and sign-out. Please do not go out to the field when dropping off or picking up your child.

LATE PICKUP POLICY

A \$2 per minute late fee per child will be charged to the person picking up the child(ren).
